Winfield Middle School: Preparing students for academic success, career development, and life opportunities!

WHAT is the after-school tutoring program...?

The after-school tutoring program is an opportunity for students to receive small group, supplemental instruction in core subject areas by certified teachers, to practice skills, and to improve achievement.

WHO benefits from the program...?

1. ANY student who wishes to receive additional academic support, especially in the areas of mathematics and reading/language arts.
2. Students who have difficulty understanding new concepts in class, who require additional explanation and/or practice.
3. Students who require additional time to complete assignments in class and may need redirection to acquire skills and maintain understanding over time.

Participation in the program may be requested by parents OR teachers. ALL students are welcome to participate, regardless of academic standing. Parents may request student participation, or teachers may refer a student to the program by contacting a parent/guardian, especially if the teacher has concerns about a student's academic performance. Students MUST have parental permission to stay after school for the tutoring program.

WHERE and WHEN may students participate in the program...?

The after-school tutoring program is held at Winfield Middle School three days a week, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, from 3:30 – 5:20 p.m.

Students may participate in the program as much or as little as desired.

HOW MUCH does the program cost...?

There is NO CHARGE for the program! It is FREE !

In addition, transportation home is available for students via school buses. The buses deliver students to MAIN ROADS/OUTLETS along the normal bus runs. However, parents are welcome to pick up students after tutoring and should arrive in the front parking area by 5:20 p.m.
